Present were Commissioner's Jerry Hoagland, and Richard Freund, Commissioner Hyer was absent, Clerk Charlotte Sherburn, Treasurer Brenda Richards, Assessor Brett Endicott, and Mary Huff.

Commissioner Hoagland called the meeting to order. Agenda items brought forth were replacement of the part-time building inspector, and repairs to a damaged sheriff's vehicle.

Commissioner Freund made a motion to amend the agenda to include consideration of the building inspector replacement and vehicle repair. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion. Freund-aye, Hoagland-aye.

Commissioner Freund made a motion to approve the Board Minutes from the December 28<sup>th</sup> meeting. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion. Freund-aye, Hoagland-aye.

Commissioner Freund made a motion to pay all outstanding bills with the exception of Sheriff Crandall's credit card bill until purchases could be clarified. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion.

I.C. Case #10-53 Commissioner Freund made a motion to deny applicant pursuant to I.C. 31-3505(4)(b) incomplete application. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion.

Commissioner Freund made a motion to repair the damaged vehicle driven by Deputy Lynn Bowman. The damage is \$1,036. The county has a \$1,000 deductible on the ICRMP policy. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion. Freund-aye, Hoagland-aye.

Commissioner Freund made a motion to place an ad in the newspaper for a part-time building inspector for Owyhee County to replace Arlyn Tietz who is taking a position in Nez Perce County. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion. Freund-aye, Hoagland-aye.

Commissioner Freund made a motion to go into executive session pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2345(1),(a),(b),(c),(d),(e),(f),(g) for attorney memos, possible litigation, and personnel. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion. Freund-aye, Hoagland-aye.

After moving out of executive session Commissioner Freund made a motion to adopt Resolution 11-01 a Resolution to Establish a Grouping, as Well as the Criteria for the Grouping for the Rights-Of-Way upon and across Land Owned by the United States of America in Owyhee County. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion. Freund-aye, Hoagland-aye.

Commissioner Freund made a motion to publish the Summary of Resolution 11-01 to Establish a Grouping, Criteria for Rights-Of-Way Upon and Across Land Owned by the United States of America in Owyhee County. The public shall have sixty days from the publication of the summary of this resolution in the Owyhee Avalanche to submit written comments to the Board as to the proposed groups, including the criteria for such groups. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion. Freund-aye, Hoagland-aye.
