Present were Commissioner's Joe Merrick, Jerry Hoagland, and Kelly Aberasturi, Sheriff Perry Grant, Treasurer Brenda Richards, Administrative Assistant Brook Russell, Indigent & Charity Director Belle Evans, Planning & Zoning Administrator Mary Huff, Prosecuting Attorney Doug Emery and Natural Resources Director Jim Desmond.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to amend the agenda to include an extension for the budget certification of the Bruneau / Grand View Schools and the Eastern Owyhee Library. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to set the agenda as amended. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to approve a 1 week extension for the budget certifications for the Bruneau / Grand View School District and for the Eastern Owyhee Library. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2014 Commissioners meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to schedule a tax deed sale for October 20, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to approve the 2014-2015 ICRMP Insurance Policy in the amount of \$106,335.00. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.

Commissioner Aberasturi made a motion to approve 5 certificates of residency to the College of Western Idaho for Camille Carver, Jacob Graves, Les Loucks, Erica Mendez and Amber Purvis. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Aberasturi made a motion to approve an increase in the Economic Development credit card limit to \$1,000.00. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to go into closed session for Indigent & Charity matters. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.

Commissioner Aberasturi made a motion to deny Indigent & Charity case 14-28, according to Idaho Code 31-3502(17); not the last resource. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Aberasturi made a motion to deny Indigent & Charity case 14-29, according to Idaho Code 31-3505(2); 10-day pre-approval applies. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Aberasturi made a motion to deny Indigent & Charity case 14-31, according to Idaho Code 31-3506; not the obligated county. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to go out of closed session. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.


The Board canvassed the ballots from the August 26, 2014 election.
